4 Matters Arising

Community Development Sub Group Meeting 19 July. Cllr Abdullah had attended but coverage of communications had been disappointing. Reports that distribution of welcome pack had caused some problems and youth issues had arisen. Arts development was progressing well.

7 Other Reports and Correspondence

North Area Committee 26 July. Cllr Payne had attended. It had been reported that an application by Barretts for some 182 properties was pending. Local Centre had been discussed, likely to include a 300 sqm convenience store, takeaway, restaurant/coffee shop and Estate Agent. SCDC was re-working the welcome pack to tailor it to both affordable housing and market housing.

Kings Hedges Road pedestrian and cyclist works (plans held on file) to start 1 August for completion early September. Committee felt re-assessment of traffic will be required on other junctions in due course. Agreed to contact Graham Lowe at CCC and ask if at the conclusion of these roadworks they will be putting the red cycle path onto Cambridge Road.

Street Names Latest map showed Rosehip Road and Chadwick Court. Occupation at 19 July was 102

SCDC Legal Officer Catriona Dunnett would report on consultation responses received for Electoral Arrangements at Arbury Park to the Electoral Arrangements Committee for end September. Cllr Payne had made enquiries on how the new Parish Council would be put in place. District Council acknowledged the need to nurture and mentor the new Council. 2 residents had indicated an early interest in becoming Parish Councillors at Arbury Park

Noise Report from Mr Stigwood forwarded to SCDC. Brian Heffernan to discuss with WSP. Cllr Payne had indicated hoped for mitigation. Cllr Ing raised confusion at Guided Bus Forum over whether the barrier was in fact absorptive or reflective

City 4 Bus Service had commenced with a bus becoming stuck due to bad constructive traffic parking

Orchard Park Primary School Gate designs provided and noted. Guide for Parents and Carers held on file. A suggestion that cars should park in the area associated with the recreation area would be queried with Governors.
