(S/0001/07/F SCDC application – Formation of Vehicular, Pedestrian and Cycleway Access Road from Histon Road to serve the urban extension of the City between Huntingdon Road and Histon Road, Cambridge, together with drainage and landscaping works – David Wilson Homes (South Midlands).
