3. To Sign & Approve Minutes of Meeting 6 November 2008

All agreed to sign as correct record

4. Matters Arising from previous meeting

Overnight HCV Ban County Cllrs following up AJC process. Agreed to review specific comments requiring response and report back to Cllr Foster. **Next agenda**
Chivers Way Pelican Crossing Vision Park Management had not responded
HGV/A14 Notes LAF meeting 6 Jan 2009 held on file. Costain Skanska Statement of Intent dated January 2009 received via JAG. Agreed to write asking for confirmation that in upgrading A14 from Milton to Girton Interchange all building materials be delivered along A14, not through Impington and Histon, as stated at public consultation
Speedwatch Cllr Kelly had attended, with others. Some concern expressed over usefulness and process. 2 local residents now trained and could in turn train others. Agreed to put details on website
Histon FC Parking Cllr Davies to attend meeting 12 Feb, this forming part of agenda
Safer Routes to Schools Review Noted no replacement for crossing patrol at The Green. Agreed to express concern to Cty Cllrs Jenkins and Bradney and offer to put any detail of vacancy on website
Budgets Noted precept recommendations to Full Council 9 Feb. Capital recommended: £4,000 for crossing area at The Green; £2750 for double yellow lines Station Road. HT&T budget: £1700 street lights £500 other
Cycling Meeting Graham Taylor September 2008 All noted article on Cllr Jenkins' website. Cllr Kelly gave brief report and agreed to put together an overview of recent discussions and plans concerning cycling
Bollards new reflectors fitted. Agreed to request these always be largest size possible

5. Count On Us Traffic Survey

Cllr Parish had reported on speeds for Police during their speed check recently
All agreed the figures could best be used as and when required. Agreed figures needed to accompany NIAB planning application response due in. Agreed a plan showing traffic flows may be very useful and interesting. Agreed Cllrs Jones, Stonham and Kelly to meet as a working group and formulate a list of possible uses for the figures and prioritise. Noted Crime & Disorder Reduction Partnership plans to locate safety camera vans in areas with speeding problems. Agreed to request Count On Us to relay site 10 (Milton Road) inside the speed limit boundary, as offered, free of charge
Chairman brought forward item 7 with agreement of Committee

7. Cambridgeshire Transport Commission

Response to questions in letter dated 26 January, responses by 6 March. Agreed to advise all Councillors to respond individually where appropriate

8. Double Yellow Lines

Apart from areas identified previously and following requests, Parish Council members had input on parking spaces in High Street; Police on New Road, and no input received from County Council

Options discussed:

- Progress Station Rd Double Yellow Lines project funding 2009-10 up to £2,750
- Formulate a wider scheme of Double Yellow Lines needs in Histon and Impington by formation of working party
- Remove from agenda

Agreed Committee would work to formulate a wider scheme but remained keen to progress Station Road. Cllr Foster to meet Cty Cllr Jenkins to discuss best approach via County Council and feed back. Noted delays in Guided Busway and consequently any parking audit as a result

Chairman brought forward part of item 10

10. **Other Correspondence and Reports** (1 of 2)

NCATP Impington PC had responded, copy held on file. AJC had met 19 January when schemes approved. Outcome discussed and concern over process. Agreed to write a joint letter objecting to the consultation process and asking for details of recourse. Cllr Kelly left meeting. Chairman returned to agenda order and reinstated standing orders

6. **Walkabout Report 2008**

Report provided for all and accepted. Agreed to request an up-date on items dealt with from Matthew Pickering for next agenda. Lamp posts survey complete. Problems remained in Hereward Close

9. **Pedestrian crossing Proposals – High Street/The Green**

Cllr Parish to provide written notes of meeting with David Lines. Noted proposals to include £4,000 in budgets for first stage costs 09-10. Once confirmed, agreed:

Stage 1 –

- Advise David Lines of budget and inform County Cllrs of scheme
- Ask David Lines to draw up a scheme and put in chain the process
- Inform Head Teachers of schools of scheme
- Feed in information and input during Safety Audit Process

Stage 2 –

- Approach CCC for toucan crossing 2010-11, using precept and/or grants

10. **Other Correspondence and Reports** (2 of 2)

Access difficulties, Station Road Cllr Jones declared personal interest. Correspondence received from business in Station Road encountering problems with access to and from car park. Matt Pickering at CCC and SCDC had been involved in requests to repaint double yellow lines and with queries regarding signs. Agreed to ask Matt Pickering for a report on proposed works. Agreed to write to Fish & Chip shop, Janes frames and Kitchensmiths, requesting deliveries ensure all entrances are kept clear following concerns expressed to the Parish Council

Cycling in Station Road Dist Cllr Chatfield had forwarded concerns from resident on safety at Vision Park junction, indicating Cty Cllr Jenkins was investigating. Agreed to ask Cty Cllr Jenkins for copies of such investigations, copy letter sent to Vision Park Management and request to be copied in on any progress made

Scotland Farms Park Lane Manager again asked for assistance where dog walkers parked and blocked farm entrance. Agreed to raise again at CCC

Citi 7 / 104 Bus Service Dist Cllr Chatfield had copied Parish Council in on various mails concerning problems with Citi 7 service. Myalls had announced closure of 104 Sunday service from 1 March 2009. Citi 7 runs till 5.30 p.m. only, whereas 104 ran into the evening. Agreed to organise a meeting with Cambs County Council to discuss the running of the Citi 7 now and in the future, inviting Dist Cllrs Chatfield and Mason
