1. Apologies for Absence

3. To Sign & Approve Minutes of Meeting 5 February 2009

All agreed to sign as correct record

4. Matters Arising from previous meeting

A14 Construction Traffic response. Confirmation the B1049 will not be used for haul routes, but subject to aggregates and bulk fill being available adjacent to the scheme. Relevant Planning application ended 9 March 2009. Agreed to respond to CCC asking for clarification on ambiguity

Histon FC Parking up-date – meeting held 19 March. Cllr Davies to be asked to provide up-date

Count On Us – No report from working group (Cllrs Jones, Stonham, Kelly). IPC had ordered new count for Milton Road at cost of £275

Feedback from recent meeting of Chairman Cllr Foster with Cty Cllr Jenkins re scheme for double yellow lines. No input from IPC, Cllr Kelly to ask for suggestions. Histon PC only put forward Station Road

NCATP Process – response from Graham Taylor setting out process followed. Agreed to refer them to fact that 3 of 5 schemes were not discussed at September meeting. Cllr Kelly to review her notes and take up on behalf of the Committee following review by Cllr Foster

Access difficulties in Station Road. Letter sent to businesses, Fish & Chip shop now displaying poster requesting considerate parking. Janes Frames have suggested 20 minute parking rule, idea to be acknowledged but advise Council have already asked for white lines via Cty Cllr Jenkins. Cty Cllr Jenkins was negotiating with Graham Lowe on dropped kerbs and white line issues elsewhere in Station Road.

Cycling issues. No copy correspondence yet seen. Standard of cycleways not up to standard with suggestions not improvement. Cllr Kelly to speak with other cyclists for views

Blocked farm entrance Park Lane David Lines advised bollards could be used to prevent parking, not without its own problems, and perhaps a sign would be best or enforcement by police if motorists are causing an obstruction of the highway. Agreed to pass advice to farm owner and note

5. HCV Ban Consultation

Consultation had been due to end 9 March. Working group to meet 20 April to consider individual responses required

6. Walkabout 2008

Matt Pickering had up-dated on items dealt with to date. Budgets for 09-10 cut considerably. Noted Cllr Thurman continued to press for agreed actions.

7. Pedestrian Crossing Proposals

Cllr Parish had provided notes of site meeting, forwarded to David Lines and agreed. Design work due to commence as early as possible. Cllr Foster continues to push with David Lines for progress. Safety Audit to follow drawings

County Council were seeking County Cllr input on proposals to supply 6 pairs of crossings (dropped kerbs) to 7 parishes, to include Histon and Impington at £1,000 per village. Clarification sought from Cty Cllr Jenkins. Cllr Foster to carry out survey of dropped kerb needs

8. Meeting at County Council re Bus Service

Report on meeting held 11 March 2009 to be copied to all Committee members. Comments received from residents through the hisimp site to be put to Stagecoach.
