**1. Apologies for Absence**

Cllrs Payne and Mason

2. No members' declaration of interest for items on the agenda.
3. Minutes accepted as true record of meeting 15 February 2007. Chairman signed minutes accordingly.
4. Matters arising from minutes as agenda items.
5. Traffic Survey. The Committee identified 13 points where a traffic survey would be helpful in identifying traffic flows and speeds. Although this was more than the original 8 points that Cottenham Parish Council used for their survey that cost £2,000, it was felt that the survey would be incomplete without these extra ones and would therefore limit the usefulness of the gathered data in giving a complete picture. It was agreed to share the proposed survey positions with Impington Parish Council to get agreement on the final survey points. It would then be necessary to get a quotation from the survey company before going back to both Parish Councils to get agreement to spend any extra monies required.
6. Safer Routes to School. It has been impossible to arrange a meeting yet with Matthew Grout the new County Council SRTS Officer to discuss any revisions to the original proposals for changes to the access to the Junior School from the Green. Cllr Parish has still to provide notes for the New School Road meeting with residents.
7. Traffic Calming. Date for the meeting with Graham Lowe to discuss proposals over replacing the current bollards in Station Road and Cambridge Road have yet to be confirmed by him. Cllrs. Parish and Pene Nudd from Impington have agreed to attend.
8. The status of the Northern Area Transport Plan was reviewed.
9. South Cambridgeshire District Council have written confirming their current intention not to sell the High Street Car Park. They do however wish the Parish Council to consider making part of the Car Park available for Business Parking that could be charged for.
10. It was agreed that the new system of alerting Councillors of proposals on changes to traffic management in the City by e-mail to the Clerk would be monitored. However only those that are likely to affect the Village would be passed to Committee members.
11. There has as yet been no response from Highways to the Joint Histon & Impington letter on the A14 improvements.
12. Minutes and actions relating to the progress of the Guided Busway were noted.
13. The Milton Park & Ride correspondence was reviewed. Current issues relating to pedestrian and cycling along Butt Lane and within the scheme were noted. It was felt that there was no point at this time to formally add to the Council's responses.
