MATTERS ARISING

H11/50.1 Outstanding list

- Brian Ing to request figures for average speed camera through AJC re A14 improvements Cllr Ing reported verbally on Area Joint Committee items, report to follow, including cycleway scheme; Northwstowe study details **BSI**
- David Jenkins to up date discussion with the HA on A14 crossing improvements Cllr Legge repeated interest in attending such meetings **JDJ**

50.2 Item 41.1 Real Time Bus Information priorities submitted. Comments received on Citi 8 service forwarded to Stagecoach. Summary of all complaints/comments requested. Request for window in shelter at School Green to aid sight of approaching bus noted. Following discussion response agreed advising RTBI board should help passengers be aware of imminence of arrival of bus

50.3 Item 42 Civil parking Enforcement response submitted

50.4 Item 44.1 Parking space removal Noted bollard knocked out by Co-Op delivery lorry 18 July 2011, with extensive damage to tarmac pavement. Insurance claim on Co-Op. Agreed to write to local Co-Op expressing disappointment and request further meeting

50.5 Item 45.2 Narrow Lane/ Windmill Lane copy response to resident provided. Cllr Parish declared personal interest as nearby neighbour. Any mirror could not be funded or organised by Cambs County Council. Noted

PRESENTATION BY MIKE READ, CHAIR CAMBRIDGE ADVANCED DRIVERS & RIDERS

H11/51 Cllr Legge declared personal interest as member of CADAR. Mike Read outlined 20 years history of organisation and differences to IAM (Institute of Advanced Motorists). With CADAR a test must be taken every 3 years. The cost of membership is £10 covering 10 meetings per annum, 2 magazines and tuition. Exam fees are additional currently at £60, 323 members, all organisers and assessors are voluntary.

Questions asked on:

- Insurance benefits. Not applicable at present
- CADAR'S association with RoSPA. Main aim of the course is for hazard perception
- Tuition covers wide range of areas e.g. correct use of gears when slowing

Members agreed it seemed a worthwhile scheme and Parish Council would ensure residents were aware of its merits

REPORTS & CORRESPONDENCE RECEIVED

H11/52.1 Cambridge Cycling Campaign request for support to build "Ring Fort Path" at Orchard Park. Histon and Impington Parish Councils both discussed the issue and reported back. Following further discussion on funding and final solutions for cyclists over A14, agreed to support the proposal, conditional that it does not dilute the funding of the A14 Crossing solutions and will be suitable for all potential users e.g. taking account of the shape/gradient.

- 52.2 Cycleway Issues Agreed to ask County for information on when lamp-posts would be removed along B1049 section. County Council had been asked to deal with weeded area at top of Orchard Road blocking safe view for exit.
- 52.3 "Your Community-Your Speed Limit" proposals. Previous policy discussed. Noted information available on-line for working out costs involved. Cllr Parish agreed to cost works for north of Village Green. Some views expressed on sensible places for change of speed areas. Cllr Ing to ask about reviews on speed limits at AJC 25 July **IMP/BSI**
- 52.4 Junior School Entrance Safety Up-Date Ownership of frontage of school on Green being clarified. Some more complaints over safety reported
- 52.5 Enterprise Car Rental Agreed to ask Cllr Foster to set up meeting for Cllrs Legge and Parish with Area Manager, before August Bank Holiday. To discuss parking issues **CJF/DNL/IMP**
- 52.6 Monitoring Process for Local Highways Issues deferred to next meeting
- 52.7 County Council Highways Issues as received, reported to Highways e.g. overgrown hedge, trees and potholes
- 52.8 Request from resident for change of right of way from South Road into Villa Road, Impington. Discussed at Impington Full Council. Agreed to respond stating it was sensible to await confirmation of any proposed development of the former SCA site. Any change in priorities would currently be at cost to Impington Parish Council
- 52.9 High Street Crossing Audit Noted local interest raised recently and agreed Cllr Parish to put together article for website/ HICourier September **IMP**
- 52.10 County Council HCV Strategy revised draft assessment process received. Noted
- 52.11 Feast Market comment regarding parking in Narrow Lane near to Butcher shop. Agreed to request County Council opinion and feasibility on suggestion of double yellow lines
