H11/58 General discussion. Noted Parish Council due to be involved in SCDC condition agreements for major works to be carried out in High Street development

REPORTS & CORRESPONDENCE RECEIVED

H11/59.1 Cycleway Updates Parish Council kept up to date by Cty Cllrs Gymer and Jenkins and Mike Davies, Project Manager. Project almost complete, lighting remained an issue, middle section yet to be finished. Milton to Impington, noted foliage now cut back hard

59.2 A14 County Council Meeting held and reported to Full Council. Feedback awaited on effect of junction changes. County Council article expected in Courier. Cty Cllr Jenkins to be asked for closing statement on whereabouts of funding previously earmarked **JDJ**

59.3 Safety Audit reported at Full Council. Indicated crossing could not be installed at Co-Op corner over to Building Society. Cllr Foster had contacted the Committee with idea for alternative crossing east of Co-Op on The Green and south of junction in Station Road. Following discussion on desire line for residents and speed related issues at these sites, **agreed** to ask David Jenkins to obtain full copy of Safety Audit and all details behind it; David Legge to meet Cedric Foster to look at site again. Suggestion for island in centre between Co-Op and Boot Inn discussed, with path built cut, possibilities of bike racks. Noted issues with access by Public

- House dray. Jointly funded minor works scheme **agreed** to confirm with County Council the Parish Council wish to retain "realignment of Station Road" as a listed project **JDJ DNL/CJF**
- 59.4 Bus Service Funding Consultation 3 Personal interests declared Cllrs Parish, Marston and Ing (bus pass holders) **Agreed** to highlight questionnaire on parish website, and to encourage individual responses. Parish Council would not respond as a body
- 59.5 Guided Bus Cllr Legge outlined recent safety concern raised, including cycle-related incidents. **Agreed** to write to Andy Campbell Stagecoach with concerns.
