2 TO CONFIRM DETAILS OF CAMBRIDGESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL A14 RAT RUN SCHEME – AS INDICATED AT JOINT MEETING 1.9.04 HELD IMMEDIATELY BEFOREHAND

- 89.1 Prior to vote, Cllr Abdullah wished to have recorded her disappointment with the decisions made, feeling it not to be what was needed and wanted, but just what Histon and Impington were to get. The recommendations for acceptance indicated at previous informal joint meeting were read out, being:
- Park Lane – gateway; speed cushions; raised junctions (15 from both Parish Councils had supported recommendation)
 - Milton Road – giveaway entry; speed cushions; raised junctions (15)
 - Impington Lane / Burgoynes Road / New Road – 20mph school advisory speed limit; speed cushions; raised junctions (14)
 - Station Road Detail 3 (north) – 20mph advisory school limit (Infants School) (15)
 - Station Road Detail 4 (south) – junction with Chequers Road and raised junction and speed cushion to south (10)
 - Cambridge Road Detail 4 – speed cushions, raised junctions and give way (13)
 - “Recognising the status quo may not be an option, the Parish Councils and County Council meet to give enough time to come up with an alternative proposal or options in time for the Area Joint Committee 8 November 2004” for the scheme for speed cushions, raised junctions and the junction with High Street in Station Road (north) (9), and speed cushions, raised junctions, cycleway, and the junction with War Memorial in Station Road (south) (14)
 - Addition of 20mph advisory school limit Histon Junior School (10)
- 89.2 Prop Cllr Gooden, sec Cllr Abdullah, the motion that “Impington Parish Council **adopt** all the recommendations made in the joint meeting, including the addition of the 20mph advisory school limit at Histon Junior School, excepting the words “status quo may not be an option” be altered to “status quo **is not** an option”. Further proposed Mr Brace at County Council be advised of these decisions, as detailed in the CCC A14 Rat Run Scheme. All in favour and carried.
- 89.3 Scheme for closure of eastern junction of Crescent with Villa Road was not supported at the joint meeting and would not be accepted.
