#### **2. Power for Shed**

Referred to Committee by Full Council, for decision. Generator: Denis had confirmed by e-mail that he was happy with the council installing power to the burial ground building and then hiring a generator for a period of time for the groundsman to trial before a purchase was made.

The following was proposed by Geoff Waters and seconded by Phil Gooden. All in favour. Clerk to attempt to arrange for A Plant to inspect the site and provide appropriate advice on the most generator for suitability of site, usage, moveability, storage etc. before the electrical installation takes place to avoid the power being installed in the wrong place. A trial period of at least two weeks in order for Terry to be able to confirm whether the supplied generator is easy to use, start and move. If so, appropriate generator then to be purchased.
