**1. Introductions and Notes of last meeting**

**2. Update on Actions**

Cllr Shona Johnstone raised the issue of direction of drainage at the last Northstowe drainage board meeting, where it was confirmed that the majority is draining through Webb's Hole.

Adrian Hames was liaising with Gallagher on the linkage of the Northstowe bus-only road into the CGB at the Oakington end and awaiting Gallagher to confirm the location.

The issues of vibration through engineering work will be included under Condition 10 in the Code of Construction practice, which will be submitted in October to Local Planning Authorities.

tures of the landscaping proposals and cross sections to the Forum.

Cross sections of the Oakington stop and nearby Beck Brook are subject to other planning conditions and therefore will be discussed in a later meeting.

The access from Northstowe to the maintenance track was discussed.

Standard chicanes will be put at the entrances to the maintenance track to stop unwanted access. There will also be CCTV at stops to monitor the route.

**5. Date of next meeting and A.O.B.**

Peter Paskell gave an update on Nuttall's Progress.

The Draft Code of Construction Practice, in particular construction access routes, was discussed.

Cllr Norman, Cottenham Parish Council, asked what routes have been proposed for transporting construction material, as sand and gravel, to the A14 and M11 in the first place.

Peter Paskell will report back to the Forum at the next meeting.

There was discussion on the traffic impacts of the CGB on Cottenham.

Adrian Hames will look at the modelling for villages as Cottenham and report back to the meeting at the 21<sup>st</sup> November.
