Comments due by Wednesday 31 <sup>st</sup> October Link to interactive maps <a href="#">click here</a> (zoom and click on site for more information) Online consultation portal <a href="#">click here</a> Detailed discussion covered: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• IVC (in vessel composting), notoriously difficult to manage odour emission</li> <li>• Public Health Issues, noting recent fire</li> <li>• Lack of publicity of consultation for residents to respond</li> <li>• Current operating systems for household waste recycling need tightening prior to the proposed new functions being carried out</li> </ul> All <b>agreed</b> to comment, <b>objecting</b> to the allocations approved in the current Minerals & Waste Local Plan carried forward into the new the plan, due to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Lack of notification/consultation of proposed changes</li> <li>• Objection to the process in that it sets precedents (i.e. providing the potential for change, new services) without prior detailed consideration, and that this therefore would make it easier to introduce those</li> <li>• The introduction of hazardous materials to the site which has only been used for non-hazardous materials in recent years</li> <li>• In Vessel Composting – odour emission. Public health risk to nearby residents, also noting the impact on residents the recent fire on site had</li> <li>• Planning permission for the existing functions of non-hazardous landfill and inert recycling expired 31 December 2020 for this site</li> <li>• The Parish Council would support improvements to the operating processes to reduce odour emissions from the site</li> </ul>
