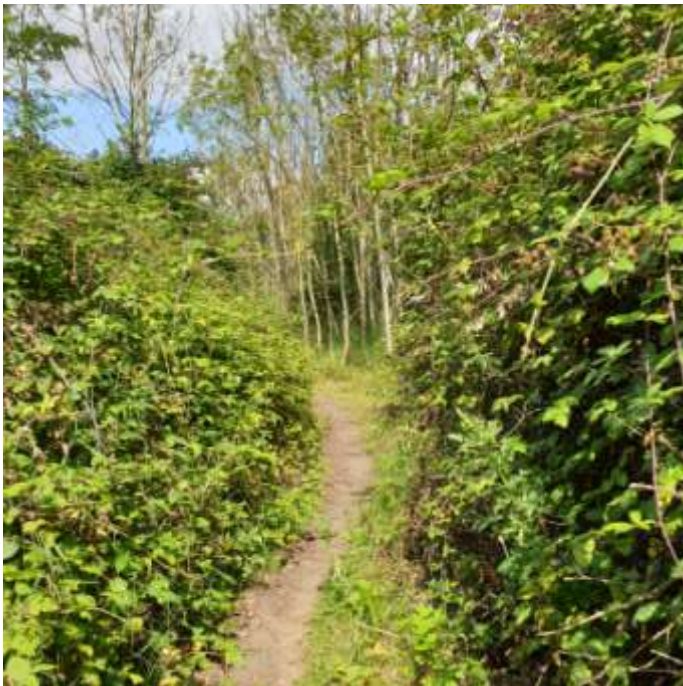


# Help us clear the shrubbery and paths!

Please bring your own water and a sunhat/waterproofs as appropriate. Please do not bring children under 5 years old or dogs. We will be cutting thorny branches. Children between 5 years and 16 years must be supervised by an adult.

This event is run by the Site Management Action Group of the Abbey Fields Transitional Management Committee appointed by Histon and Impington Parish Council to manage the Croft Close Set-Aside and Long Meadow until a Friends Group can be set up.
